Town of Stockton Board Meeting

Monday, July 11th, 2016

Town Hall, 7252 6th Street, Custer, WI

6:30 pm

1. Call to Order by Chairman Mike Bronk at 6:30 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Supervisor Jeanne Dodge, Supervisor Jerry Piesik, and Clerk Lauri Novotny also present. Treasurer Sandy Walters was excused.
2. Motion (Dodge/Piesik) to approve the agenda for July 11th, 2016. Motion carried 3-0.
3. Motion (Dodge/Piesik) to approve the minutes for the Regular Town Board Meeting of June 27th, 2016. Motion carried 3-0.
4. Anyone wishing to address the Board – No one came from the audience came forth with issues or concerns, however, two recent calls to the Clerk’s Office were discussed. The first topic involved the property line between the Custer Post Office and the adjacent lot, more specifically, the driveway portion of the property. As this wasn’t an agenda item, the Board could not make a decision but Supervisor Dodge asked that the GIS Map that was located by Clerk Novotny be shared with the Post Office. Chairman Bronk suggested that maybe the Post Office personnel could talk with the owner of the building and possibly offer funds to the adjacent land owner for an easement. He further reiterated that the Town can’t interfere in easement related issues.

The second topic involved a call in regards to residents along Custer Road that have been leaving their garbage cans in the road right of way. This topic was previously discussed with Road Foreman who also indicated that this area continues to be an issue with garbage cans creeping further and further in to the road. Chairman Bronk asked that Clerk Novotny draft a letter to the five homes along Custer Road that appear to be an issue and indicate to the individuals that the Road Right of Way needs to remain free of debris including garbage carts.
5. Mower for Parks – Chairman Bronk recently spoke to Jeff Herman, Road Foreman, who stated that there is nothing new in regards to the mower for the Parks. No bids have been solicited. No further discussion has been held in regards to purchasing a mower. Supervisor Piesik mentioned a used deck that could be purchased which would improve the life of the existing mower. Chairman Bronk indicated that Supervisor Piesik should get together with Jeff Herman to facilitate the installation of the used deck. Supervisor Dodge indicated that postponing the purchase and/or bids would be in the Towns best interest.
6. 2016 Road Work – Chairman Bronk reported that the Road Crew is working on crack filling, getting ready for chip sealing. Chip sealing should be occurring within the next couple of weeks.
7. Motion (Dodge/Piesik) to approve checks numbered 31499 to 31541 and ACH transactions numbered 160589 to 160592. Motion carried 3-0.
8. Chairman Bronk presented the application materials and fee received from Mid-State Sisters of Skate to obtain a temporary Class “B” picnic licenses for the event scheduled on July 30th, 2016. Motion (Dodge/Piesik) to approve the Picnic License request by Mid-State Sisters of Skate for the event scheduled on July 30, 2016 and to grant such licenses for issuance. Motion carried 3-0.
9. Chairman Bronk presented the application materials and fee received from three individuals wishing to obtain Town of Stockton Operator’s licenses for the period July 11th, 2016 to June 30th, 2017. Motion (Dodge/Piesik) to approve the renewal of Operator’s Licenses and to grant such license for issuance to Lindsay Wroblewski, Brandon J. Somers and Shaun Vincent Przybylski. Motion carried 3-0.
10. Correspondence – Chairman Bronk shared with the Board a copy of the Payment Advice received from the State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation the payment of \$48,009.10 received by the Town. In addition, he also shared a copy of the payment received from the State of Wisconsin Department of Safety & Professional

Services a check in the amount of \$9,914.46 which corresponds to the 2% Fire Dues. The last piece of correspondence was a letter from WPS informing the Town of a reconstruction project along County Road J that will begin in 2017.

11. Clerk's Report - Clerk Lauri Novotny informed the Board that we received funds for the NSF check previously reported from one of the local establishments. She also reported that the next election is on August 9th and she's in the process of working on Election related tasks. Finally, the Wisconsin Towns Association Meeting is scheduled for Monday, July 25th, at the Town of Stockton Town Hall which means that our Regular Town Board Meeting will be on Tuesday, July 26th.
12. Chairman Bronk reminded members that any item wishing to be on a future agenda should be provided to the Clerk in advance.
13. Motion to adjourn (Dodge/Piesik) at 6:53 pm. Motion carried 3-0.
