1. Call to Order: Chairman, Mike Bronk, called the Special Town Meeting of the Electors to order at 6:34 pm. A list of attendees is attached with five electors present as well as Chairman Mike Bronk and Clerk Lauri Novotny.
2. Report on 2017/2018 Budget Figures: Chairman Bronk summarized the 2017 revenues and expenditures as well as the 2018 proposed budget.
3. Motion (Jeanne Dodge/Cindy Davis) to adopt the 2.532128 municipal mill rate and set the 2017 municipal tax levy at \$617,757.00 to be collected in 2018 from Town of Stockton residents. Motion carried 7-0.
4. Motion (Marie Helminiak/Cindy Davis) to exceed the 2018 budget if necessary and approve total Road Maintenance funding not to exceed \$5000/mile of Town road in accordance with Wis. Stats. Section 82.03(2). Motion carried 7-0.
5. Other topics brought up to be discussed by electors – Marie Helminiak inquired as to the status of the Town of Stockton Park Shelter. Chairman Bronk explained that the shelter was initially constructed at the recommendation of two architects, however, the structure appeared not to be strong enough to sustain the heavy winds and weather that occurred. The roof collapse occurred and, thankfully, no one was injured. The insurance was contacted and a claim filed. With the rebates available and further price discounts, we will be able to build a stronger, more wind friendly type of building ensuring that the posts are in the ground vs anchoring on top of the concrete as originally suggested by the architects. Jim Dodge inquired as to whether or not the extra light pole that is on the side of the Town Hall could be moved to the ice rink area to provide better lighting for night time skating activities. Chairman Bronk indicated that the Board could consider this at a later time.
6. Motion (Marie Helminiak/Terry Johnson) to adjourn at 6:39 pm. Motion carried 7-0.
