1. What needs to be done.
 - Planting of wildflowers
 - a. Jerry & Jim have mowed the flower area to prepare for this year's growth.
 - b. New seeds for the second flower area need to be planted in May to grow this year.
 - c. Because of lack of volunteers' town crew will be hired to spread the 3 to 4 inches of black dirt mix on the stacked area. Time cards will be marked Park, so they are paid from the park account. Hopefully this can be done the 1st or 2nd week in May. It will be discussed with the Town Chair.
 - d. Dirt will be leveled, stoned picked, flower seeds sowed and covered with dirt and watered every second or third day if needed.
 - Trail preparation
 - a. Needs to be 60' wide for mower and trucks for materials
 - b. Brushed and leveled where needed.

Noted by committee and added to the Town Board agenda if necessary that "Any none town equipment used to prepare or maintain the park, if it needs to be repaired, the owner is reimbursed for the cost of repairs."

2. Park Clean up
 - Park is in good shape and no clean up from the winter is needed except for some pick up of sticks.
 - Town crew needs to move picnic tables out by parking lot and gym set.
 - Grills will be installed when it is seen where people congregate.
 - In the town newsletter will be noted that persons that use the park to walk their dogs bring along plastic bags to pick up after themselves.
3. Building of Lodge – at this time is not possible
