

Town of Stockton Park Committee Meeting Minutes

7252 6th Street, Custer, WI

Thursday, July 6, 2017 6:30 PM

Park Committee Members Present: Jerry Piesik Chair, Marie Helminiak Sec., Jim Dodge, Ray Olson, Keith Novotny

Jerry Piesik called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM at the Town Hall. Minutes approved as presented.

A. Reports:

- **Town Shelter Building**

1. Bids from the previous meeting were approx. without final details included.
2. County zoning permit is needed for a commercial building. Commercial building codes and materials will be used.
3. Jerry Piesik shared building plan with committee.
4. Discussion with contractor Novotny changes your made to the shelter as;
 - a. Building will be 20' x 24' with 2' eaves with the concrete 2' past the posts so rain runoff will hit the grass and cause less splashing and run off.
 - b. Roof will be a gable with scissor trusses 2' on center, shingled with lifetime shingles.
 - c. No center post on gable ends but 4 unwrapped posts on sides. Posts can be wrapped later if desired.
 - d. Posts will be 10' tall to result in a 9 1/2' ceiling. Posts will be anchored to the concrete.
 - e. Ceiling will be covered with a raised center for more height.
 - f. Colors will match the playground equipment. Green shingles, brown soffit & trim, sandstone colored ceiling.
5. **Concrete** size will be 24' x 28' Another bid will be gotten for concrete from Badger Concrete in Plover.

- **Walking path**

1. Trail has been cleared, downed trees cleared.

- **Wild Flower planting**

1. Jerry Piesik and Jim Dodge have finished the project.

B. Actions

- **Town Shelter Building**

1. Piesik will get new bids. Menards will not be asked for bid because of previous high bid.
2. Road crew will be asked if they can dig hole and level ground for concrete. Footings will need to be 1' deep for posts.
3. Keith Novotny, his crew and others have volunteered to construct building. Several volunteers are welcome but not too many because of liability reasons.

- **Wild Flower Planting**

1. None needed but occasional rain.

- **Walking path**

1. Some clean up still needed.

C. Next meeting agenda items – review of new bids, discuss reaction of Town Board.
